About us

Czeslaw Milosz Primary School with Integration Classes No. 36 is located in Rybnik. It's a city in southwestern Poland, in the Silesian Voivodeship. The city of Rybnik has a population of about 140 thousand inhabitants. It's a charming and friendly city with historical buildings and a beautiful market square. The Rybnik area with its large coal mines and power plants is an important economic region of Poland.

Our school is an eight-year public school, which realizes the goals and tasks resulting from the law, educational and preventive program of the school adapted to the developmental needs of students.



There are 414 students in 18 classes. Two of them are integration classes with students of special needs and one is a bilingual class, where students learn history and geography in two languages – Polish and English as well. Students are aged from 6-7 to 15 years. There are 45 highly qualified teachers employed at the school. Among them there are educationalists, special pedagogues, pedagogical therapists, speech therapists, career counsellors prepared to diagnose the needs, talents and strengths of students.





Main goals:

- Our priority is to make sure that the school is child-friendly, that it helps the child in his or her comprehensive development and creates the conditions for discovering his or her talents and interests.
- Our school is made up of open-minded and creative people, who enable students to succeed according to their individual abilities, who develop children's cognitive curiosity and their willingness to improve themselves.
- We have many years of experience in running integration classes for students with special needs.
- The school organizes a variety of extracurricular activities, in accordance with the expectations of students and parents, didactic and equalization activities, sports clubs, interest groups, corrective and compensatory activities, revalidation, preparing for competitions and different contests.
- We provide the best conditions for learning and development thanks to a modern didactic and sports base. The building of our school is spacious, safe, well equipped, also adapted to the needs of students with disabilities. It is located away from busy streets. It is surrounded by a vast green area where students can safely and actively spend breaks, develop physical fitness and play.

A bit of history ...

The beginnings of the present Primary School No. 36 in Rybnik, Poland date back to 1988, when the construction of the following buildings started. It took 9 years to finish all the construction work. On September 1, 1997 the school was officially opened as a primary school. For 17 years, from 2000-2017 the school was a junior high school. The year 2017 brought unexpected changes. The reform of the educational system in Poland introduced the liquidation of junior high schools and restored an eight-year primary school.







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
